







Discover the Cumberland Plateau...



The perfect place to locate, live, and enjoy.

The Cumberland Plateau stretches across eastern Tennessee from Alabama north into Kentucky, with Cumberland County Tennessee right at the heart of it. Carved over time by flowing water, the plateau rises more than 1,000 feet above the Tennessee River Valley to a vast tableland of sandstone and shale that dates as far back as 500 million years. Once a remote wilderness, the Cumberland Plateau with elevations reaching up to 3,500 feet, still boasts the world's longest hardwood-forested plateau, harboring many plants and animals found nowhere else. In fact, due to the mild climate with average summer temperatures of 72.8 degrees, one of the highest number of plant species in the world are found here, second only to a remote region of China.

Prior to 1805, what is now Cumberland County was originally hunting grounds of the Cherokee, Creek, Choctaw and Chickasaw nations. Although they hunted the region, they never established permanent dwellings. The rough and rugged terrain discouraged early adventurers, but eventually English, Scots-Irish and German settlers staked their claims in the valleys and occasionally ventured to the plateau to harvest timber and mine coal. Cumberland County was established in 1855.


In the center of the county, 4 roads met and crossed. At this intersection was one of the first buisinesses built in this area, Scott's Tavern. Because of it's location at the major crossroads between Knoxville, Nashville and Chatanooga, Mrs. Scott suggested the name, "Crossville." The City of Crossville was incorporated in 1901.



Many local historic landmarks are created using the rare rose-khaki colored rock, Crab Orchard Stone. It is known world-wide and is quarried right here in Cumberland County. Many businesses incorporate our native stone into their architecture, although the majority is shipped to other states and other countries.

With such a moderate year-round climate and so much natural beauty surrounding us, it is easy to find plenty of outdoor activities to engage in and so many places available to enjoy them. From the Cumberland Mountain State Park, the Caryonah Hunting Lodge & Preserve, to the Catoosa Wildlife Management area, it's no wonder people are drawn to the Plateau - especially when you consider all the other options. Live entertainment, historical and cultural attractions, fine restaurants, winery tours, shopping, and the close proximity to major cities - while still enjoying a small town atmosphere - make us truly unique.

Cumberland County provides the beauty of the Tennessee landscape as well as generous offerings of culture, recreation, and technology. With its extremely low crime rate, low tax rate, near perfect weather, and economical housing, there is no other place like it.


TAX FACTS

- No State Income Taxes on wages
- No Personal Property Taxes
- ▶ Real Estate Property Taxes vary, depending on size, location, and features of the home. For a typical \$300,000 home, your taxes would be little more than \$1,000 per year.






Weather & Lakes

One of the most enjoyable features of our area is the moderate year-round climate. Mild summer days and cool summer nights are attributable to the elevation of the Cumberland Plateau, which also allows for much lower humidity levels than most of the south. Even during the hottest months, the relative humidity only reaches about 72%. While we do get snow in the winter months, it's usually no more than an overnight dusting that fades quickly, at most a couple of days.

Keep in mind, of 56" total precipitation, almost 11" of that is snow. This is what creates our naturally lush, green environment and allows the many trees, grass, and foliage to thrive. Because it is spread throughout the year it never feels particularly rainy or dry.

Most residents here take full advantage of our picture-perfect weather. Among the many options of how to fill your days and nights, throughout Fairfield Glade are 11 beautiful spring-fed lakes for your boating and fishing pleasure. The crystal clear waters are stocked with large and small mouth bass, yellow perch, bream, shell crackers, crappie, channel catfish, and blue catfish. The deep waters and high oxygen content provided by the springs of Lakes Dartmoor, Kirkstone, and Glastowbury are home to rainbow trout and walleye as well.

Medical & Health

Here in Fairfield Glade, we have our own paramedic team and ambulance service on call 24 hours a day. You can feel secure knowing they, as well as our Fire and Police Departments are professionally trained and certified, offering our residents total protection.

Our local hospital, Cumberland Medical Center, is only 9 miles away in the city of Crossville. A 182 bed regional medical center, CMC is fully accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations. The acute care hospital offers special services not usually found in smaller, more rural medical systems. At CMC you will find a state of the art Regional Cancer Center with Image Guided Radiation Therapy, hyperbaric medicine and wound center, an inpatient rehabilitation facility, 24 hour Emergency Department, a fully staffed Same-Day Surgery Unit, Comprehensive Outpatient Services, Cardiac Rehabilitation, Home Health Services, and more. The Lifeline program is a personal emergency response system for elderly patients. The system in their homes is connected to the Emergency Department, offering security and peace of mind.

Most impressive is the beautiful facility located in the center of Fairfield Glade. The 25,000 sq ft Medical Arts building offers a primary care clinic, digital mammography, physical therapy, occupational therapy, aquatic therapy, and laboratory services.

The Wellness Complex offers membership services that include a walking track, aerobics classes, yoga, Zumba, PiYo, Studio Cycling, senior aerobics, aquatics, and cardiovascular equipment. It is staffed by certified personal trainers who will work with you to develop an individual training program, as well as group fitness instructors who offer group exercise classes.


At the CMC Wellness Complex, you can attend Health Classes that provide cooking demonstrations, guidance for weight management, diabetes support, nutritional information, and more.







Golf & Tennis



The Golf Capital of Tennessee.

A golfer's dream! 3 of Tennessee's Top Ten courses are right here in Cumberland County. That's 11 courses with a total of 216 holes of championship play. Our near perfect weather, gorgeous scenery, and affordable accommodations, all come together to create the perfect environment for the Game of Kings.

Fairfield Glade is home to 5 championship golf courses, with a combined total of 90 holes that will challenge every golfer. Each course offers 18 holes - with the exception of one that offers an amazing 36 holes! The most renouned course is Stonehenge. It was rated the Number 1 New Resort in the United States by Golf Digest Magazine when it first opened, and has consistently ranked in the Top 20 every year since. In fact, The Tennessee Open has become a seasonal event at this world class course.

Even though the courses here at Fairfield Glade are in the same geographical location, each one bears its own remarkable and unique characteristics, and vary in beauty and challenging play. If mountain vistas appeal to you, Druid Hills is your choice. However, if you prefer relatively flat terrain, you will want to try Heatherhurst. If you're hitting short but straight, and you like contrasting nines, Dorchester is your course. Need something even more challenging than usual? The Blue Tees at Stonehenge are there for those with "professional" aspirations. Remember, tee times are recommended five days in advance. The resort offers 4 state-of-the-art heated indoor tennis courts. The surface of these courts are cushioned with 5 coats of shock absorbing rubber granules, formulated to respond to body impact, reducing foot and leg shock as well as fatigue. Or, if you prefer, there are 4 outdoor Clay Hydro Courts with underground watering, keeping the courts in perfect playing condition around the clock.



Places, Things & People






In 1965 an actor-writer-composer-director-producer named Paul Crabtree moved from California to his wife's hometown of Crossville to write a book, and ended up helping the local school with their production of The Perils of Pinocchio. The people were so captivated by the performance they decided to build a playhouse, forming a corporation and selling stock to raise the money. The Cumberland County Playhouse produces Broadway style musicals, comedies, dramas, and hosts concerts as well. It has grown into Tennessee's largest professional theater, presenting more than 500 performances each year.

The old Palace Theater in downtown Crossville was built in the late 1930's, where it was the hub of entertainment in a growing southern town. It fell into disrepair in the early eighties, but was resurrected and restored to its original glory, reopening in early 2001. It is now a center of entertainment, which includes showings of classic cinema, live performances by musicians, comedians, magicians, and other entertainers


